Due to unforeseen circumstances Afro-Sax have had to change their proposed programme from "Jazz and Co." to Jazz Variations. This has not affected the budget or venues.

DOUBLE EDGE

A budget has been agreed with Double Edge for touring their production 'The Remnant'. Dates and Venues have been confirmed.

HOUNSLOW ARTS CO-OPERATIVE THEATRE.

DANCE

We have now agreed a budget with Greeta Mendez to produce "From Coffee Beans to Disinfectant". The first week of performances will take place at the Almeida Theatre, which is available for one week only beginning 23rd March 1986. We are still looking for a venue to stage the other three weeks of performances. Greeta is also looking for a full time administrator.

FROM RESISTANCE TO REBELLION

The Institute of Race Relations have begun work on this project. A venue has not yet been finalised but there is a strong possibility that the exhibition will take place at the Shaw Theatre or Pentonville Gallery.

An advisory panel consisting of Wilf Walker, Seema Gill and Parminder Vir has been set up to oversee the project as a whole.
