4 Black Productions Ltd - (E/AR 417)

Agreed that subject to compliance with conditions (a) - (c) below a grant of up to £21,015 and a guarantee against loss of up to £4,500 (a maximum payment of up to £500 per concert) be made to Black Productions Ltd to promote 9 concerts

CONDITIONS

- (a) Standard grant conditions 1, 5, 21-30, 35, 39, 40 and 49
- (b) the 9 concerts taking place
- (c) any awards payable being reduced proportionately if any of the concerts listed in paragraph 8 of E/AR 417 are cancelled.

5 Minority Arts Advisory Service - (E/AR 416)

Agreed that subject to compliance with standard grant conditions 1, 5, 21-30, 31, 38(i) (3 years), 39 and 49 a grant of £4,350 be made to Minority Arts Advisory Service for essential micro-processor equipment and associated items.

Urgent Business

6(i) Ceddo Film and Video - (E/AR 418)

Agreed that subject to compliance with conditions (a) and (b) below the following amounts be awarded to Ceddo Film and Video to enable the group to pay V.A.T. owing on the film and video equipment purchased with a grant made by the Sub-Committee on 7 March 1984:-

- (1) a grant of up to £2,048 for the V.A.T. element on equipment purchase of £13,651

Decision

- (2) a grant of up to £4,875 of prescribed expenditure for the V.A.T. element on purchases of equipment, subject to a future allocation of prescribed expenditure becoming available within 1985-86.
- (3) a payment of £102 towards V.A.T. undercharges subject to the Director of Finance receiving satisfactory documentation and evidence.

CONDITIONS

- (a) Ceddo Film and Video demonstrating to the satisfaction of the Director of Finance that full effort has been made to claim such V.A.T. as is possible from the Customs and Excise
- (b) Ceddo Film and Video registering for V.A.T.

Agreed, that the following grants be made to Carib Theatre Productions/ Carib Theatre-in-Education in respect to the period 1 April 1985 to 31 March 1986:-

- (a) £45,000 for revenue and project costs identified in Paragraph 13 of (E/AR 419) subject to
 - (i) Compliance with standard grant conditions 1, 5, 21-35, 48 and 49.
 - (ii) the Director of Recreation and the Arts being informed of all artistic activity by submitting publicity information.
- (b) £1,000 for the purchase of a small van subject to
 - (i) compliance with standard grant conditions 20, 37, 38 and 47.
 - (ii) the van being used for transport of the cast, sets and costumes
 - (iii) Submission of an invoice of purchase of the van to the satisfaction of the Director of Finance within 3 months.

Decision

Agreed

- (1) that the report (S/BS5) be received;
- (2) that officers prepare a report on the use of the South Bank facilities by ethnic minority groups and on ways in which their use can be encouraged further.
- (3) that subject to the agreement of the Arts and Recreation Committee the Ethnic Arts Advisers on the South Bank Sub-Committee be Nick Axarlis and Wilf Walker.

Agreed

- (1) that subject to compliance with conditions (i)-(iii) a revenue grant of up to £48,000 be made to Dance Company 7 in respect of the period 1 April 1985 to 31 March 1986 for the following purposes:
 - (a) two tours of venues in the Greater London area totalling a minimum of 30 performances and 30 workshops.
 - (b) a four week special schools project.

CONDITIONS

- (i) submission of a programme for the tours and for the special schools project to the satisfaction of the Director of Recreation and the Arts;
 - (ii) submission of a revised balanced budget for the period to the satisfaction of the Director of Finance; and
 - (iii) compliance with standard grant conditions 1, 21-32, 35 and 49.
- (2) that no grant should be made in respect of the application from Dance Company 7 for technical equipment.
