TRIANGLE HOSTS MAJOR BLACK PHOTOGRAPHIC EXHIBITION

REFLECTIONS OF THE BLACK EXPERIENCE
13 May - 28 June in the Gallery.

The work of ten of Britain's foremost Black photographic practitioners is on show at the Triangle Gallery during May and June. This is the first showing outside London of an exhibition which breaks new ground: for the first time, a group of Black photographers were commissioned to express and reflect the most pressing issues facing their communities. Each photographer was asked to submit 10 prints, and the result is a varied and stimulating show, unified by the desire of all taking part to achieve autonomous representation.

The exhibition was funded by the Greater London Council Race and Equality Unit before abolition, under the co-ordination of Monika Baker. It was first shown at the Brixton Art Gallery.

The photographers represented are: Marc Booth, Vanley Burke, Armet Francis, Sunil Gupta, Mumtaz Karimjee, David Lewis, Zak Ove, Ingrid Pollard, Suzanne Roden, and Madahi Sharak.
