3. That the applications listed in Appendix J be categorised as medium priority with a view to some being re-categorised as high priority if and when further funds become available.
4. That the grants for operating costs as set out in Appendix E awarded in former years and not yet paid be rolled forward for payment out of the 1985-86 budget.
5. That the grants made in former years and not paid, as listed in Appendix F, be cancelled.
6. That the grants made in former years for buildings and equipment and not yet paid, as listed in Appendix K, Section A, be rolled forward for payment out of the 1985-86 budget. Those grants made in former years and not paid as listed in Appendix K, Section B be cancelled.
7. That the Leisure Activity Grants as set out in Appendix M, Section A, awarded in former years and not yet paid be rolled forward for payment out of 1985-86 budget.

## Grants - Budget and Priorities in 1985-86

1. The Committee's base budget for grants in 1985-86 was drawn up on the basis that the Committee would spend the same amount on grants in 1985-86 as in 1984-85 with a 5 per cent increase for inflation. As the Committee and its Sub-Committees have a number of applicants who have been receiving revenue funding on a regular basis, there is little scope for reappportioning the grants budget between the various categories of grants without causing hardship. On a direct comparison with 1984-85 grants the total grants budget of £14,696,000 should be apportioned in 1985-86 as set out in column (b) below. It will be noted that although the proposed allocations balance the amounts available in the budget, some grants may not be taken up in full. The situation will be carefully monitored during the year and any savings brought to the Committee's attention.

2. Over the past two years, the Community Arts Sub-Committee have been reducing the number of drama applications in their portfolio of grants, and a number of such applications have been passed to the Arts and Recreation Committee. There were still a few drama applicants who were funded last year by the Sub-Committee but are considered more suitable for funding by the Arts and Recreation Committee and the budget has been amended to take account of this. Two applications that were formerly considered by the Ethnic Arts Sub-Committee have been transferred to the Arts and Recreation Committee and adjustments will be made in the budget for

these applications also. Details of proposed revisions to the grant budgets are set out in Appendix A and are reflected in the revisions in column (b) above.

### Major Bodies

3. The base budget has set aside £3,675,000 for the four major bodies which represents a 5% increase on 1984-85 as follows:

Detailed reports on each of the major bodies will be made to the meeting of the Committee on 8 May 1985. This report will also consider the position of the Cottesloe Theatre as additional provision has been made available to the base budget to enable this theatre to re-open in July 1985.

### Main Committee - Grants for operating expenses

4. In view of the situation regarding the Council's budget as a whole, it is essential in 1985-86 that the Committee work out a strategy for their grants budget which assumes that there will be little or no scope for supplementation later in the year. In these circumstances, I am recommending the Committee to set aside a sum to cover the cost of making grants to all those applicants who received grant last year and have or are expected to have applied to the Arts and Recreation Committee for grant in the current year. A suitable amount to set aside for this purpose is some £3,917,000, which is sufficient to make grants to all the applicants listed in Appendix B, with a 5 per cent allowance for inflation, plus an element for necessary additional costs. In some cases, applicants have been given emergency funding for the first quarter of 1985-86. A list of non-recurring 1984-85 grants is set out in Appendix C totalling £813,684.
5. Other calls on the budget before any new applicants are considered are (a) £689,434 commitments on Main Committee operating expenses to make grants in 1985-86, as set out in Appendix D; and (b) £114,622 in respect of grants made in former years but not yet claimed, as set out in Appendix E.
6. The grants listed in Appendix F have been outstanding for a considerable length of time. All the applicants concerned have been contacted by the Finance Department on several occasions, and all have been contacted again during the past three months. I am therefore recommending that as in some cases the grants are known to be no longer required and in others the applicants have been contacted and have

repeatedly failed to provide the necessary information to enable their grants to be paid, the grants should be cancelled and no provision for them made out of the 1985-86 budget.

7. I have examined all the applications received or expected in 1985-86 and the priorities I propose for the applications so far received are set out in Appendix G. I have categorised all expected recurring applications, whether or not already received, as high priority. No other applications have been categorised as high priority unless there are sufficient funds to make a grant out of the base budget.
8. The applications which in my view should be given high priority for grants out of the base budget are as follows:-

(a) High priority 1984-85 applications

There are a number of high priority applications still outstanding from 1984-85, in most cases they were not considered owing to lack of funds. A full list of the outstanding high priority applications with the grant requirements totalling £703,086 is set out in Appendix H. As there seems little likelihood of sufficient funds becoming available in 1985-86 to enable the Committee to make grants to all these new applicants, I am recommending that they should all be re-categorised as low priority, with the exception of the following which I recommend for high priority:-

- \* This body has been funded on a regular basis for a number of years, but the 1984-85 application was not processed owing to pressure of work. A grant in respect of the operating deficit for 1984-85 is therefore being recommended, and the Co-op's high priority 1985-86 application will be put before the Committee later in the year.

(b) Casualties of the "Glory of the Garden" policy

A number of London arts bodies have their Arts Council funding cut completely as part of the policy set out in the "Glory of the Garden". The bodies affected in this way are listed below, and I am recommending the Committee to make grants to cover the shortfall in all cases, except the London Orchestral Concert Board which could be given extra grant later in the year if funds become available.

As CAST, Croydon Alternatives and the King's Head Theatre are all in a situation where they have ceased or will have to cease operations unless alternative funding can be found I am recommending all these applicants for additional grant early in the financial year. The total amount of extra grant required from the GLC to keep these three bodies operating is estimated at £118,000.

It would appear that the Tricycle Theatre could continue to operate with its Arts Council grant which has been reduced by 16%, but if the Committee wish to restore this cut, additional grant of £13,920 would be required.

In view of the Council's budget situation as a whole, there will be sufficient funds to restore the Arts Council cut to the London Orchestral Concert Board and this may result in a net loss of income at the Royal Festival Hall of £23,000, calculated on the basis of 10 concerts being cancelled and orchestras paying cancellation fees of £2,000 per concert.

The local council have intimated to Queen's Theatre Hornchurch they are prepared to meet £90,000 of loss of Arts Council contribution which would result in increased GLC contribution of £58,000.

(c) "High +" applications

Applicants previously funded by the Committee and urgently requiring a higher level of grant in 1985-86 have been give "High +" priority. Some of the bodies concerned have expanded their activities using GLC capital grant, and these are marked \*. Applications in this category are set out below, in order of priority:-

There are insufficient funds to make all the grants at the levels requested. I am hoping that it will be possible to make worthwhile additional grants out of the base budget to all the applicants concerned except the ICA at levels which although perhaps lower than applied for will enable the bodies to continue to

thrive and expand. I am hoping that this objective will be achieved with a total global sum of £250,000 by offering substantially less than the amount applied for in some cases but to enable the bodies to complete their planned programmes a further £300,000 would be required. If on closer examination of the applications, the Committee decide to award a higher level of grant than is recommended, the sum that I propose should be set aside for these applications will prove inadequate even for the limited funding proposed at this stage, and some of the applications lower down in the order of priority may have to be recategorised as medium priority. The ICA will be recommended for additional grant if and when the funds become available.

9. There are a number of new applications for grant in 1985-86 which meet the Committee's criteria and to which they might wish to make a grant, but for which funds seem unlikely to become available. All these applications have been categorised as medium priority in order to avoid raising unrealistic hopes. In the event that more money for grants becomes available, some of these applications can be recategorised as high priority and processed accordingly. Medium priority applications are set out in Appendix J, in order of priority, totalling £562,197. These priorities will be subject to change as the year progresses, and there may well be additions to the list for "one-off" events and projects, as much will depend on the amount of additional funds obtained and the stage of financial year at which the extra money becomes available.

10. The additional requirements to fund new initiatives can be summarised as follows:-

#### Buildings and equipment

11. In previous years, the Committee have set aside a sum for the purpose of making non-prescribed capital grants for buildings and equipment. Despite a general acute shortage of funds for grants this year, I am recommending the Committee to continue this practice, on a minimal basis, as small capital works are sometimes essential to the operations of the bodies supported by the Committee. The amount included in the budget for this item is £325,000. However, I am recommending that £106,351 of this amount be used for the Leisure Budget so reducing the amount available for grants for Buildings and Equipment to £200,000 compared with approvals in 1984-85 totalling in excess of £1 million. If the Committee decide to confirm the grants outstanding

from former years as set out in Appendix K, the amount remaining will be £84,083. Applications for building and equipment grants have not been prioritised. One high priority application for 1984-85 is being recommended for substantial funding, and the rest of this budget will be retained to respond to small non-prescribed capital applications of great urgency.

#### Prescribed capital grants

12. The Committee have no budget for the purpose of making prescribed capital grants. Applications which the Committee might wish to consider should funds become available are listed in Appendix G. No attempt has been made to place them in order of priority at this stage, because if the Committee obtains any funds for this purpose much will depend on how much capital is obtained and the stage of the year when it becomes available. Clearly, however, as the Committee will observe from the Appendix G, the demands for prescribed capital are enormous reflecting the considerable cultural development being generated in London as a result of the Committee's policies. However, the Committee should be aware that there are a number of inescapable commitments from previous years for capital grants and a further report will be submitted to Committee when the situation regarding the availability of capital monies in 1985-86 is known.

#### Leisure

13. In 1984-85 the Arts and Recreation Committee approved a drawing of £100,000 on revenue reserves for new developments in respect of Arts Grants to be set aside for the purpose of making grants for Leisure Activities the total amount of grants requested by Leisure Activity applicants namely City Farms and Adventure Play Grounds in 1984-85 amounted to £828,294 which comprised £310,314 for capital and £517,980 for revenue.

The Arts and Recreation Committee was only able to meet a small proportion of these applicants owing to the limited Leisure Budget available to it. Of the 14 high priority applicants outlined in AR 1603, the prioritisation paper, 10 were funded. Of the 9 high priority applicants subject to further funds becoming available only 2 were funded.

14. The Committee were able to meet a large proportion of these applications only because they received a number of virements that were made from other Committees. Some of these virements were for projects that were previously funded by other Committees, prior to the policy decision that all Leisure Activity Grants should be dealt with by the Arts and Recreation Committee. Other virements were for projects which met the priorities of these Committees. Of the 9 high priority applications funded, 3 were funded through virements and the 2 funded high priority subject to further funds becoming available were funded through virements.

15. Without these virements in 1985-86 the Leisure Budget available to the Committee will be halved. The Committees who agreed virements to the Arts and Recreation Committee in 1984-85 indicated these would be one-off payments and would not be repeated in 1985-86. If the Leisure Activity Budget remains at the level of 1985-86 the majority of this amount will be taken up with re-funding of established clients at an estimated level of £77,003. This will effectively reduce the number of new Leisure projects that the Committee will be able to fund and thereby reduce the power of the Committee to implement its priorities for Leisure Activities.
16. Other calls on the budget before any new applicants are considered are:
- (a) £23,964 commitments on Leisure Budget to make grants in 1985-86 as set out in Appendix M, Section C; and
  - (b) £32,387 in respect of grants made in 1984-85 but not yet claimed as set out in Appendix M, Section A.
17. I am, therefore, recommending that the Committee agree to increase the Leisure Activity Budget to £250,000 the total amount of 1984-85 Leisure Budget as supplemented by virements with a 5% increase for inflation in line with Arts Budget. This change has been reflected in the levels recommended by reducing the amount available to Buildings and Equipment. Earlier paragraphs in this report identify the implications behind this recommendation for the Committee's consideration.
18. Owing to pressure of work, the Leisure applications received in 1985-86 have not been prioritised, beyond giving high priority to applicants who received a grant last year. A report on this aspect will be submitted at the next meeting of the Arts and Recreation Committee.

## Visual Arts

19. In 1984-85 the Visual Arts Budget of £50,000 was fully approved. If the Committee were to spend a similar amount on Visual Arts in 1985-86 an appropriate budget would be £53,000. The Committee will note that approvals against the Visual Arts Budget for 1985-86 totalling some £71,000 have already been approved which would result in the Visual Arts Budget being overspent by £18,000. As there are a number of calls still to be made on the budget, mainly in respect of exhibitions at the Royal Festival Hall and purchases of works of art, I am recommending that this allocation be increased to £85,000.

## Community Arts

20. If Community Arts Grants are to be awarded at the same level as 1984-85 with an allowance for inflation a budget of £2.525m would be required after adjustments between Committees referred to in paragraph 1 of this report. However, such a budget does not include grants approved from the 1985-86 budget during 1984-85 totalling some £392,000. Nor does it take into account annualisation. Both considerations suggest that a budget of £3.4m would be required. However, such a budget does not take into account funds to allow for the consolidation of the Sub-Committees policies in developing underprovided areas of activity, particularly in the field of Irish projects and music-related projects, or the will to maintain the Visual Arts Budget for one-off events. A further £0.6m would be needed for these purposes. A minimum of £4.0m is therefore necessary to maintain in the Sub-Committee's highest priority areas - an increase of £1.5m on current proposed provision.

## Ethnic Arts

21. If the Ethnic Arts Budget in 1985-86 is to be at the same level as the 1984-85 budget with an allowance for inflation, a budget of £1.745m would be required after adjustments between Committees referred to in paragraph 1 of this report. However, during 1984-85 over 50 applications rated high priority could not be considered by the Ethnic Arts Sub-Committee because of a lack of funds and resources.

Applications (from 1984-85 clients) submitted to the Sub-Committee indicate substantial expansion in terms of personnel and programmes, partially due to support in previous years by the Ethnic Arts Sub-Committee. However, an Ethnic Arts Budget in 1985-86 at the same level as the 1984-85 budget with an allowance of 5% makes no budgetary provision for annualisation rollovers from 1984-85 which remain unpaid expansion or new initiatives (worth £0.5m) which have been identified and have the support of Advisory Members.

This suggests a minimum budget of £2.5m to enable the Ethnic Arts Sub-Committee to carry out its 1985-86 programme effectively. This should be set in the context of a total bid to the Sub-Committee of approximately £5m with

applications prioritised as high by Advisors but not yet notified by the Sub-Committee likely to total £3.4m.

### Sports

22. If the Sports Grants are to be awarded at the same level as 1984-85 with an allowance for inflation a budget of £1.120m would be required.

A paper approved by the Sports Sub-Committee on 18 April is attached as Appendix L. This paper clearly sets out the Sub-Committee's need which will be considerably in excess of this initial budget provision.

### Conclusion

23. I am recommending that initial reports to the Committee should recommend increases up to 5% above 1984-85 base levels as set out in paragraph 1 except in exceptional circumstances where flexibility between budgets can be achieved.
24. In addition the Committee should note the shortfall identified in previous paragraphs between the current allocation and the amount required to meet expected demands. This shortfall can be summarised as follows:

2. In addition, an 'in principle' decision to make a grant of £8,654 to East London Marine Venture, was made on 15 November 1984, for which confirmation is required.
3. The expenditure identified in 1 and 2 can be met from funds recently made available to the Sports Sub-Committee in 1985/86.

4. In addition to the above, officers from the Sports Grants Section of the Department for Recreation and the Arts have identified several areas of likely expenditure falling within 1985/86. Members attention is drawn to the total of estimated revenue expenditure, (£680,000). The figures given are officers' estimates of probable expenditure and are merely intended as a guide for members.

5. The total commitments identified in paragraphs 1 and 2, are £173,204. In addition, approximately £75,000 of expenditure is due to be agreed, at today's committee and officers have identified £680,000 of probable expenditure in 1985/86. At the time of writing, budget provision for Sports Sub-Committee is not known. Last year's 'base' budget was £1,066,000. Assuming a similar provision is made in 1985/86, this would leave approximately £138,000 available for new and additional funding.

## Priority Commitments on 1985/86 Revenue Expenditure

### Concurrent Report (15/4/85) by Director of Finance

1. The proposal set out in the main report may proceed within the terms of FGP 1066 as the proposed grants can be met from the 1985/86 base budget provision for grants.

2. The Arts and Recreation Committee has not yet agreed the overall apportionment of the 1985/86 grants budget, however an interim allocation of £275,000 is being sought and Committee may approve the recommendation from this allocation. Approval of the expenditure would limit Committees ability to respond later in the financial year to other grant applications.

3. The main report sets out details of twelve revenue commitments made in 1984/85 against the 1985/86 base budget for grants each of which was "subject to funds becoming available" and one "in principle commitment" made in 1984/85 in respect of 1985/86 which was subject to confirmation by Committee. The total commitment against 1985/86 revenue budget amounts to £173,204.

4. Having checked my records I am able to concur with the details set out in the main report recommendation.

5. As regards the listing of likely expenditure and the assumption of budget provision to be allocated to Sports Sub-Committee I am unable at the present time to offer any concrete advice to Committee. Following the apportionment of the overall Arts and Recreation budget for 1985/86 I will be able to advise Committee of the financial implications of the proposed high priority applications identified in the main report.

6. The Policy and Resources Committee, on consideration of the reports PR1 and PR2 decided, inter alia, that, pending urgent detailed reports on the decision of the Council to allow for lower revenue expenditure by all programme grants totalling £42m, service committees:

i) should work towards full implementation of their programmes as reflected in the approved base budget for 1985/86.

but

ii) shall, pending these urgent reports and decisions thereon, not enter into firm commitments beyond an initial allocation made for the purpose amounting in the case of the Arts and Recreation Committee to £59.387m, viz. £6.600m below the approved base budget for the year of £65.987m.

For the time being, therefore, the Committee will need to have these decisions in mind in considering this and any other proposals for revenue expenditure in 1985/86. Officers will bring forward proposals for expenditure only to the extent that they will not cause the interim allocation to be exceeded.

6. Under financial standing orders this report does not require the concurrence of Finance and General Purposes Committee since none of the individual grant recommendations will involve expenditure in excess of £50,000 in one financial year.
